

# EAST SIDE RE-RIDES CONSIGNMENT TOUCH-UP SERVICES

Items accepted for consignment must be functional and clean.

If an item requires cleaning, polishing, repair, laundering, conditioning, touching-up, and so forth, East Side Re-Rides will either refuse the item (temporarily or permanently) or -with consigner agreement- charge a cleaning/repair fee.



## SCHEDULE OF CLEANING/TOUCH UP FEES

LEVEL	SERVICE	EXAMPLE	FEE
1	tiny touch-up	bit of colour on a scuffed spot on a boot.	\$15.00
2	bit of a clean	clean dusty items, pet hair, mud, bugs	\$25.00
3	recondition (boot)	remove dirt, clean leather, re-colour, shine	\$28.00
4	launder/clean	non-leather dry-clean or launder	\$32.00
5	recondition (jacket)	remove dirt, clean leather, spot re-colour, oil	\$40.00
6	full repair	Massive repair, patch, clean	as quoted

## DETAILS

The fee is expressed as a percentage of your consignment. If we don't sell it, you don't pay it.

### Nitty gritty:

Fee is expressed as a change in consignment percentage, in the favour of East Side Re-Rides, sufficient to cover the costs to Re-rides of cleaning/repairing the item. The cleaning fee is fixed by level of care (only a single fee is charged per item), and the exact consignment percentage will therefore vary depending on the starting price of the item.

Over time, the tagged selling price of an item diminishes (within a range), and therefore so does the amount of fee the consigner pays. East Side Re-Rides accepts the gamble of getting a lower repayment for cleaning if we can't sell in the first few months.

This part is important. This fee is levied ONLY if the item sells HOWEVER items which have had a cleaning fee assessed against them MAY NOT BE RECLAIMED by the consigner until East Side Re-Rides has had them for sale for 90 days. (Unless the cleaning fee is paid in full by the consigner)
